

## Christian Stronghold Church Bible Study Notes 2/5/25

### Theme: “The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Holy Spirit”

*(2 Corinthians 13:14 – “The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen.”)*

The phrase “**communion of the Holy Spirit**” comes from the Greek word *koinōnia*,

This word describes the deep and ongoing relationship that believers are meant to have with the Holy Spirit. Below are six key aspects of this communion:

#### 1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Holy Spirit (*Relationship & Presence*)

**Definition:** Fellowship (*koinōnia*) means **companionship, close association, and mutual participation** in a relationship.

- The Holy Spirit **dwells within us** (John 14:16-17) and is **always present** in our lives.
- Just as a close friend is near, the Holy Spirit is always available to **comfort, counsel, and guide us** (John 16:13).
- Fellowship means we should **converse with Him daily**, acknowledging His presence in all things.
- True fellowship with the Holy Spirit **brings joy, peace, and revelation** (Romans 8:14-16).

#### **Application:**

- Spend **intentional time in prayer** and worship, allowing the Holy Spirit to commune with you.
- Recognize that **He is always with you**, whether in joy or trials (Psalm 139:7-10).
- Walk **sensitive to His presence**, avoiding things that grieve Him (Ephesians 4:30).

#### 2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Holy Spirit (*Unity & Oneness in the Spirit*)

**Definition:** Sharing together means **mutual participation**—what we receive from the Spirit and what we share with others through Him.

- The Holy Spirit **binds believers together** in unity (Ephesians 4:3).
- He distributes **spiritual gifts for the benefit of the whole church** (1 Corinthians 12:7-11).
- We are called to **share the fruit of the Spirit** (Galatians 5:22-23) and His presence with others.

**Application:**

- Engage in **corporate worship** and fellowship, sharing the Spirit's work with others.
- Use your **spiritual gifts** to edify and encourage the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:12-14).
- Walk in **love, peace, and unity**, recognizing that the Spirit unites us (Colossians 3:14-15).

**3. The \_\_\_\_\_ with the Holy Spirit (*Co-laboring & Empowerment*)**

**Definition:** Participation means **active engagement in what the Spirit is doing**—being led and empowered by Him.

- We are **co-laborers** with the Holy Spirit in fulfilling God's work (Acts 1:8).
- He empowers us to **pray effectively** (Romans 8:26) and live righteously (Galatians 5:16).
- True participation requires **yielding to His leadership** and moving as He directs.

**Application:**

- Ask daily, "**Holy Spirit, what do You want to do through me today?**"
- Be **obedient** to His leading, whether in small promptings or major decisions (Galatians 5:25).
- Rely on His **power and strength**, not your own (Zechariah 4:6).

**4. The \_\_\_\_\_ with the Holy Spirit (*Closeness & Personal Revelation*)**

**Definition:** Intimacy refers to **deep closeness, personal connection, and trust in the Spirit**.

- The Holy Spirit **reveals the deep things of God** (1 Corinthians 2:9-10).
- He **speaks to our hearts** with personal revelation and understanding (John 16:13).
- The more we commune with Him, the **more sensitive we become to His voice**.

### **Application:**

- Spend **quiet time in God's presence**, listening rather than just speaking (Habakkuk 2:1).
- Ask for the Holy Spirit's **guidance in understanding Scripture** (John 14:26).
- Develop a **habit of listening**, asking, "**Holy Spirit, what are You saying to me today?**"

### **5. \_\_\_\_\_ with the Holy Spirit (*Companionship & Affection*)**

**Definition:** Friendship with the Holy Spirit means having a **personal relationship where you love, respect, and enjoy His company.**

- Just as Abraham was called a **friend of God** (James 2:23), the Holy Spirit desires **friendship with us.**
- Friendship is built on **trust, love, and communication.**
- A true friend **walks with you**, and the Holy Spirit is the **closest companion we will ever have** (John 14:16).

### **Application:**

- Talk to the Holy Spirit **throughout the day**, not just in structured prayer times.
- Be **aware of His presence** in daily activities, inviting Him into every part of your life.
- **Love what He loves** and avoid things that grieve Him (Ephesians 4:30).

### **6. \_\_\_\_\_ with the Holy Spirit (*Mission & Obedience*)**

**Definition:** Partnership means **working together toward a shared goal**—fulfilling God's purpose on the earth.

- The Holy Spirit is our **helper and counselor** (John 14:16).
- He gives us **boldness to witness** (Acts 1:8) and empowers us for ministry.
- Walking in partnership with Him means **aligning our lives with God's mission.**

### **Application:**

- Seek the Holy Spirit's **leading before making decisions** in ministry and life.
- Step out in **faith and obedience**, trusting that He will empower you (Acts 4:31).
- Stay **mission-minded**, realizing that everything you do is a part of God's greater plan.

**Conclusion: Living in the Communion of the Holy Spirit**

When we embrace the **communion of the Holy Spirit**, we experience a **deeper, richer, and more vibrant spiritual life**. This communion is not just a theological concept but a **daily reality** that transforms how we walk with God.

### **Six Ways to Deepen Your Communion with the Holy Spirit:**

5. **Step Out in** \_\_\_\_\_ – When He prompts you to act, trust Him and obey.
6. **Walk in the** \_\_\_\_\_ – Live a life yielded to His leading, reflecting His fruit.
